## Context

The environment has no respect for national boundaries: natural habitats and weather patterns often spread across several regions or several countries. That is why efforts to protect the environment of regions around the Mediterranean can be more effective when they extend across borders. **Given its focus on cross-border cooperation, the ENPI CBC Med Programme is a natural fit for environmental initiatives.**

The **38 environmental sustainability projects** funded under the ENPI CBC Mediterranean Sea Basin Programme are divided into the following areas:

- Water management (8 projects);

- Integrated coastal zone management (10 projects).

This capitalization event aims at analyzing and discussing key topics addressed and main results achieved by the projects financed under ENPI CBC MED Programme 2007-2013, in view of identifying good practices and common valuable approaches. ## **VILLA CELIMONTANA – How to get there**

Villa Celimontana is located 2.7 km from train station “Termini”.

It can be reached by metro (closest stop is “Colosseo”, Line B). The venue can also be reached by bus (n. 714, 714 (Direction “PALAZZO SPORT”, stop LARGO AMBA ARADAM)).

Villa Celimontana is a public park of the city of Rome. From the entrance of the park, participants should look for “Palazzetto Mattei”, headquarter of “Società Geografica Italiana”. It is located 150 meters from the entrance of Villa Celimontana.
